MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL

• Electric air horn • 3 electric windshield wipers • Electric automatic bilge pumps (3) with watertight bulkheads to sole level • Seacocks on all thru-hull fittings at or below waterline • Engine heat exchangers for fresh water cooling • Stainless steel drip pans under engines • Engine room exhaust blowers • Water-cooled exhausts venting through transom under swim step • All engines silenced with high position pot type water-cooled mufflers • Deck filled fuel tanks of welded black iron with baffles, hand hole clean-out plates and sight glasses • Deck filled fresh water tanks of stainless steel, with baffles and hand hole clean-out plates • Water pressure system with 20 gallon hot water heater • All deck filler caps marked with gallonage • All fuel tanks fitted with individual diaphragm type shutoff valves at tanks • Manifold fuel valves in engine room for maximum tank selection • Morse throttle and clutch controls • Complete instrument panel and controls at both steering stations • Engine hour and voltmeters at lower station • Mechanical steering • Emergency steering tiller with deck plate for access • All underwater gear including rudders, shaft logs, stuffing horns, struts, etc., are of bronze • 12 kw diesel generator, flexibly mounted with sound shield, aqua muffler and fresh water cooling • Panel mounted heater and starter buttons • Separate 12 volt, 195 amp hour heavy-duty lead acid generator starting battery with fibreglass box and cover • Two heavy-duty lead acid 195 amp hour engine starting batteries with fibreglass boxes and covers • Each battery equipped with master cutoff switch • Electronic rectifier and battery charger with charge divider and diode controlled charging rate • Engine batteries paralleled for starting • Service use of batteries through three-position, vapor proof master switch • 12 volt and 115 volt three-wire electric systems with separate AC and DC panels and circuit breaker protection • All wiring of insulated copper, color coded and loomed • Alternators on each engine • Separate 115 volt shore power system with polarity indicator and ship/shore switch • 115 volt receptacles throughout • Copper bonding throughout • Limber chain • Mast spreaders and rigging • Engine room sole of nonskid sheet aluminum •



Stainless steel double lifeline rail on bridge deck, with teak trim • Bronze stanchions with teak rail on side decks • Teak rail aft with hinged gate to swimming platform • Ladder to swim platform • Bulwark cap rail, teak • Exterior trim, teak • Teak burgee and ensign staffs • Closed chocks and mooring cleats forward, midship and aft • International rule navigation lights • Anchor light at masthead • Side deck and cockpit lights • All decks including cockpit, laid teak • Forecabin deck hatches, teak framed with perspex • Half oval bronze stem band • Bronze chaffing strips on all rub rails • Cockpit scupper and self-bailing • Teak handrails all around cabin sides • Yacht name and hailing port plaques for transom • Yacht name plaques for side of flying bridge • Starboard and port boarding gates • Stainless steel standing rigging • Braided dacron running rigging • Mast and boom • Mast spreaders • Anchor bowsprit and pulpit •

• All interior teak is golden Burmese with satin finish varnish • Teak parquet on all cabin soles • Teak trim and paneling • Upholstered furniture has foam cushions • All berths are fitted with 6" foam mattresses • Teak bar with three bar stools • Teak "L" shaped settee • Teak dining table with hi-lo and in-out features • Teak bookcase • Teak armchairs • Teak end table • Teak convertible settee • Teak buffet • Stereo system with speakers in main saloon and owner's cabin • Four-burner gas or three-burner electric range with oven • Galley exhaust fan • Teak cutting board • Stainless steel double sink • 18 cubic foot 110 volt duplex type refrigerator-freezer with ice maker • Trash bin in galley opens on side deck for disposal • Private enclosed heads with showers • Tub with shower in owner's head • Clothes hamper in owner's head • Sliding and opening windows throughout for good ventilation • All windows 3-ply safety glass • Teak handrail on main cabin overhead • Cabin headliners acoustical vinyl • 30" eight-spoke teak steering wheel • Water pressure and oil temperature alarms • Wheelhouse settee and stowage space including chart drawers •
